Teaching Phonics Using Game-Based Instruction

Course Outline – Summer 2023

Beginning Phonics

Teens learn how to teach phonics to beginning and struggling readers by using game-based instruction. Since the courses are offered on Zoom, students need to have a buddy for the second hour of every class to play the games. A buddy may be a parent, friend, sibling, grandparent, etc., and may change from class to class.

Curriculum

Class 1

Hour 1: What is phonics? What is the alphabet? What are consonants? What are vowels? What are short vowels? What are CVC words?

Hour 2: Practice using consonants and short vowels by playing games.

Class 2

Hour 1: What are long vowels? What are VCE word patterns? How to apply suffixes S, ES, ED, ING with CVC and VCE words?

Hour 2: Practice VCE word patterns as opposed to CVC word patterns and when to apply suffixes S, ES, ED, ING by playing games.

Class 3

Hour 1: What are long vowel digraphs? What does "Y" as a Vowel mean?

Hour 2: Practice long vowel digraphs and "Y" as a Vowel by playing games.

Class 4

Hour 1: What are R-Controlled vowels? What are Diphthong Patterns?

Hour 2: Practice R-Controlled Vowels and Diphthong Patterns by playing games.

Course Materials

Each student will receive all materials needed to participate in the course.

Student Materials: Beginning Phonics Downloadable textbook for teaching phonics.

8 Phonics SuperDeck card decks.

Course Dates

The course is offered two times during the summer to accommodate vacation and work schedules. If the student is unable to attend one or more of the classes during the week they register they may watch the recorded sessions on-demand or make arrangements to make up the classes in another session if space is available.
