Game Based Instruction

Research shows that learning and retention increase when students learn by playing games because anxiety decreases, focus increases, and there's unlimited purposeful, playful practice.

Student Buddy

A Buddy may be a parent, friend, teacher, sibling, grandparent, etc. The buddy can be a different person each time and only needs to be present during the second hour of the class.
